European Community Regulation on Chemicals

This document refers to the European Regulation (EC) 1907/2006

Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation (and Restriction) of Chemicals **REACH**

STATEMENT

The REACH Registration/Notification process does not involve whole products or articles, but rather:-

- Substances on their own
- Substances found in preparations or mixtures
- Substances found in articles which could be released during use.

All of our products are classed as "articles" and, with the exception of small quantities of lubricants contain no fluid substances, preparations or mixtures.

Lubricants used in products manufactured and marketed by Winlock Security Ltd; do not contain materials which are (at the date of statement) included in Annex XVII of the above EC Regulation. As a result, none of our products require registration.

It should be noted that traces of Chromium (VI) are contained within the passivation film of yellow zinc plated components. Winlock Security Ltd no longer manufacture components with yellow passivation films. However, we reserve the right to use up existing stocks of such components, except when their use contravenes the following European directives:-
